He's a great lover of Italian traditions like spend Sunday and festivities with the family and watching football matches in tv. He say he feels very lonely and ignored by his community and he's mad about the technological gap that divide him from new youngest generations.

INTERVIEW 2

For our second interview we asked an old widow female about her. She likes playing burraco with her friends and when she can't she uses her tablet; she also likes spending time with her family, most of all during festivities and on Sunday lunch. She enjoys ancient Neapolitan music and superstitions and she values faith, family and loyalty as very important aspects in her life. She finds it hard to connect in person with people because she can't do things she could do before, as it causes her discomfort; she would very much like to learn how to use technology, especially to reach her grandchildren living in another city, but she usually gives up because it's too hard for her and all of this contributes to increase her feelings of loneliness and anxiety.

INTERVIEW 3

We obtained important information after an interview with Angelina. She is 78 years old and She lives with her husband. She is very frustrated because she would like to spend more time with her grandchildren but she can't because they are too busy.

She doesn't know how to use technological tools and she doesn't use a mobile phone.


She spends most of the day watching television, or waiting her grandchildren call her. Family is the most important thing she has.


