In particular, we would like clarification regarding the book's aesthetics, what will be included in it, whether the pages will be pre-designed or blank and to be filled from scratch, as well as information about its dimensions.

Product 2:"Family Secret Recipe" Shared Cookbook

This is a lightweight, zero-technical-threshold solution that starts with "recording" and "sharing" to directly touch the core of cultural inheritance.

## 1. Product Composition and Implementation

Physical Part: Custom "Family Secret Recipe" Cookbook - Design: An exquisitely designed notebook. The cover features Neapolitan-style elements (e.g., lemons, blue sea, volcanoes). Inside pages are not blank but structured templates:

- "The Story Behind This Dish": Record who is good at making this dish and any family anecdotes associated with it.
- "Ingredient List": Detailed ingredients and quantities (traditional descriptions like "a pinch" or "appropriate amount" are allowed).
- "Step-by-Step Illustration": Leave blank spaces to encourage users to paste printed step photos or hand-drawn sketches.

- 2"Cooking Assignment": Encourage younger generations to replicate the recipe and post process and finished product photos in the group.
